COUNCIL RESOLUTION 12-13-2023 – #75

RE: CHIEF AND COUNCIL LEADERSHIP ON TRADITIONAL TERRITORY

WHEREAS:

- A. The Vuntut Gwitchin First Nation Constitution calls for either the Chief or Deputy Chief to be present on the Traditional Territory at all times;
- B. From time to time the Chief and Deputy Chief must attend to matters outside the Traditional Territory, such as government business or family matters.
- C. Personal and family needs are recognized by Vuntut Gwitchin Government as priorities and should be accommodated.
- D. Chief Pauline Frost and Deputy Chief Debra-Leigh Reti are each required to travel out of the Traditional Territory for different reasons, but at the same time, from December 19 to 21, 2023.
- E. The Vuntut Gwitchin First Nation Constitution states that in the event that both the Chief and Deputy Chief must be absent, an interim Deputy Chief shall be appointed.

THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE VUNTUT GWITCHIN FIRST NATION RESOLVES THAT:

1. To ensure leadership presence on the Traditional Territory, Councillor Kyikavichik is appointed as interim Deputy Chief of the Vuntut Gwitchin First Nation for the period of December 19 to 21, 2023.
2. Councillor Kyikavichik will be present on Traditional Territory during the absence of Chief Pauline Frost and Deputy Chief Debra-Leigh Reti.
3. Chief Pauline Frost and Deputy Chief Debra-Leigh Reti will be available for remote communications to maintain quorum of the Council, to the extent that is practical.
4. In the event of any governance questions, Chief Pauline Frost will be the spokesperson.

THIS RESOLUTION being duly approved by a quorum of the Council at a meeting duly convened on December 13, 2023 at Old Crow, Yukon.


